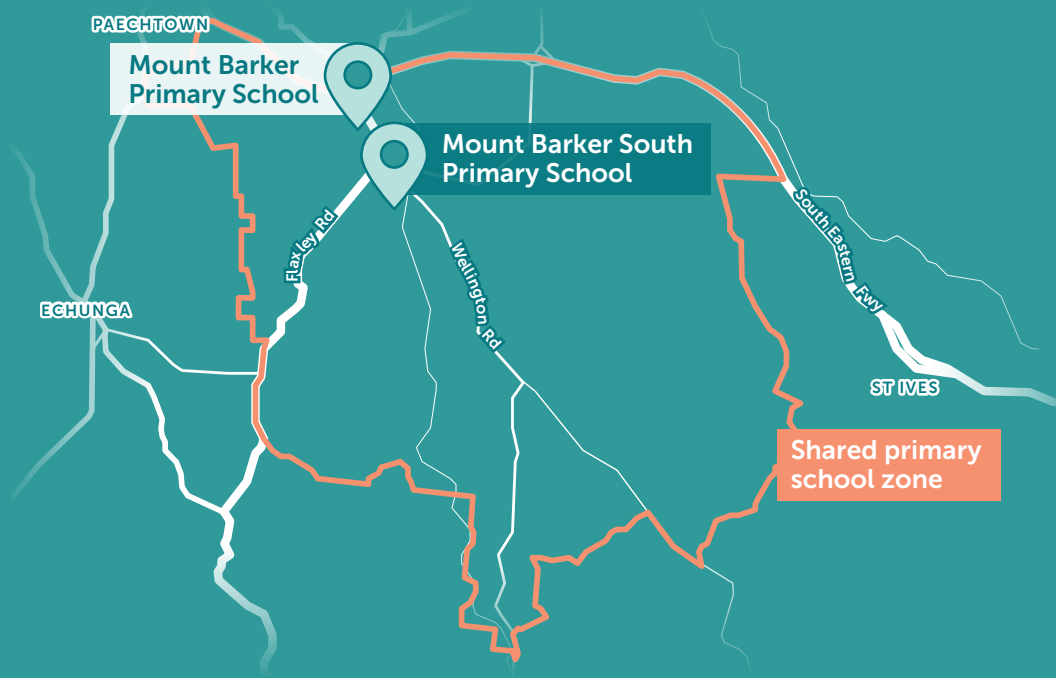


MOUNT BARKER SHARED PRIMARY SCHOOLS ZONE

The **shared zone** will combine the catchments of both primary schools and expand to include the areas of Mount Barker, Mount Barker Springs, Mount Barker Summit, Bugle Ranges, Wistow and Paechtown.

The **shared zone** will support both schools to effectively manage increasing enrolment demand until the new Mount Barker primary school is opened in 2028.

What does the shared zone mean?



- When there is a shared zone between 2 schools, families living in the zone may nominate their preferred local school. If there is no place at the nominated local school, the child will be referred to enrol at the other shared school.



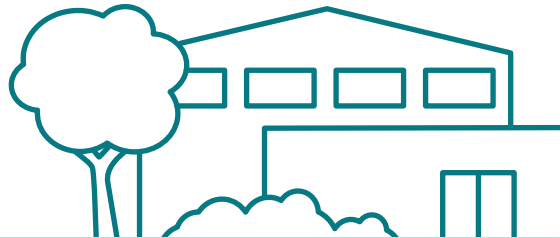
- If demand from families living in the shared zone is higher than the places available, children may be allocated to either school. The allocation depends on available places and considerations such as a sibling being at the school, distance from home to the school, social and family links, and transport needs.



- The principals will work together to balance their enrolments and determine the best schooling option for the family, including the accommodation of younger siblings in the future.



- The schools will continue to accommodate non-local families as per the Department for Education's placement procedure. This includes Aboriginal children, children in care or children with an older sibling at the school. For more information how placement is determined visit www.education.sa.gov.au/enrolment
